Traditional Large Quilt or Modern Large Quilt - 120" x 120"

(May enter one in traditional or one in modern category but not both.)

Lap/Twin Quilt - 70" x 85"

Wall Hanging - 45" x 45"

Miniature - 25" x 25"

(No strip may be larger than 1" finished width.) A strike hand being and the strike hand being and best and the strike hand being an attack the strike hand being attack the strike h

Challenge Quilt - 45" x 45"

Two color quilt (May only use two colors in the entire quilt.) Must be pieced by more than one person. (All those contributing to piecing must be members of STQG.)

Art Quilt - 45" x 45"

(Must be an original piece.)

Holiday Quilt - 65" x 75"

Flowers, Flowers, Flowers - 45" x 45"

STQG Guild Block of the Month - 75" x 85"

(display only, not-judged)

(Choice of 2016-17 STQG Guild Block of the Month Quilt or 2017-18 STQG Block of the Month or Challenge quilt. Can enter only one quilt in this category.)

Ouilted Accessories

Quilted bag

Quilted pillow or pillow sham

Quilted table runner

(Items must be at least 50% quilted, may enter one item in each category)

Antique Quilt - (display only, not judged)

May enter two quilts in one category provided there is room. Only one will be judged.
