Don't Forget!

If you are lucky enough to own a quilt finished before 1950, you may want to consider entering it into the Antique Quilt category at the show this September. We, as quilters, have an obligation to promote the care of all quilts – especially the older quilts that are part of our heritage. And we can certainly help folks get familiar with the history of quilting by showing examples of quilts done before us!

The full Guidelines were published in the September, 2017, Newsletter. You would use the same registration form that is used for regular quilt entries. A color photo with the owner's name and the name of the quilt (if known) should be attached to the entry form. The quilt should consist of three layers quilted together. Don't worry if some of the batting shows through. There is no size restriction, and no sleeve is required. You will want to attach the owner's name on the back of the quilt either permanently or safety pinned temporarily. For the quilt's protection it should be in a cloth bag with the owner's and quilt's name on it. Please write as much as you know about the quilt on the back of the entry form. Tell about the maker of the quilt, approximate time it was made, where it came from etc. The more you can tell, the more interesting it will be. Even if you rescued the quilt from a yard sale, tell that!! Antique quilts are not judged or included in Viewer's Choice. Members may enter two quilts, if space permits.
