After a discussion at the meeting we decided that next summer we would each draw a piece of fabric from Donna's donation and use that piece to make something for the Challenge category for the 2020 show.

There are lots of opportunities to make something new out of something old, e.g., taking old handkerchiefs, old embroidered tablecloths, dollies, etc. and creating something new for that category. Size of that category to be determined and announced in November.
