Supplies to bring:

1. Seasonal and/or Holiday fabrics. Don't need a lot, but at least 4 x 6 pieces.
2. Optional: ribbons, lace, tulle, Angelina, fabric glitter paint, color pencils, etc.
3. Batting, a regular weight, and, if you prefer muslin for your backing, bring it. We will have paper postcards to use if you like.
4. Sewing machine and regular sewing supplies, cutting mates, don't have to be big ones, rulers, and rotary cutters.

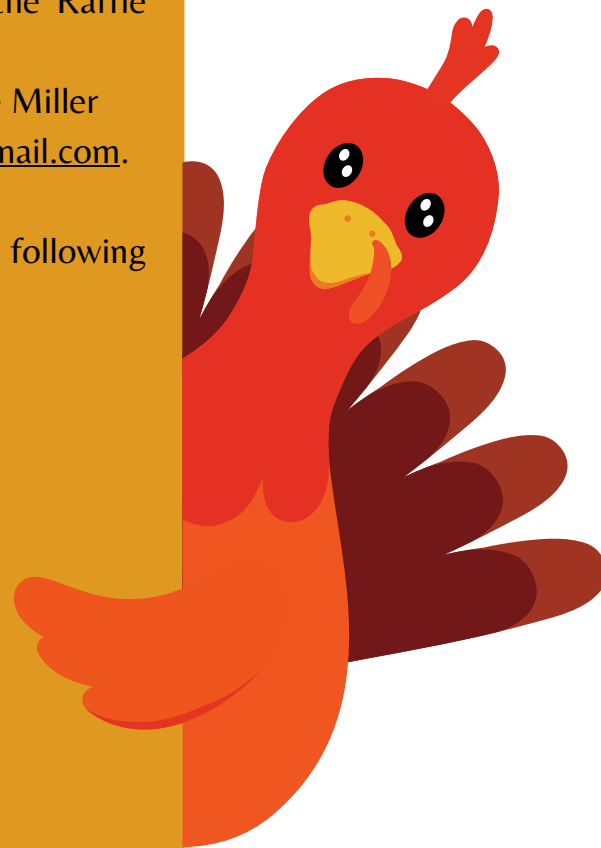
