The 2024 Calendar Project!

The idea is that you can make 1 block per month so that at the end of the year you will have a quilt made with 12 blocks. We will give you a general theme for each month that you can use as a jumping off point for your own creativity. You can use any method to create your blocks, mixing and matching to your heart's content, i.e. quilt as you go, traditional block designs/construction, stitch and fold, paper piercing, embroidery, applique, whatever you can think of, as well as making your blocks any size you want.

The theme for January is "SNOW". During the January meeting we will reveal the theme for February, during the February meeting the theme for March, etc.

I chose to do my blocks using the "quilt as you go" method; as an example here is a picture of my January block. If you choose to do that method you will have to start with a 14" square of fabric for a FINISHED 12" block (which is what I did). I used rulers to create my "snowflake" then filled the rest of the square with free motion quilting. With this method you quilt your blocks as "you go" then piece them together once they are all quilted. That is why you have to start with a larger square that you then trim to size before piecing.

Remember you can decide to make any size block using whatever method you want; the whole project is your design and inspiration based on the monthly themes. So get creative!!
