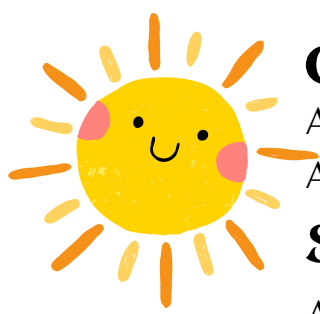

We spent the morning sketching and visualizing Alternative Grids, Modern Traditionalism (taking a traditional block style and alerting it or skewing it to be more modern, Minimalism, and Negative Space. In the afternoon we played with improv piecing. No rulers or measuring here! Just cut and sew....this was a little scary for me but ended up being very freeing! 2025 Challenge Category

For those of you who missed the last quilt guild meeting, we selected the challenge quilt guidelines for the 2025 show. Challenge quilts may be no bigger than 45" x 45". They must be black and white with one additional fabric. The additional fabric can be any color or multi-colored. You can only use one specific additional piece of fabric that you choose to go with black and white colored fabrics. Your black and white fabrics do not need to be solids but can only be black and white.

Show Judge

We are pleased to announce that we have secured a judge for the quilt show. Nancy Fuqua, our judge for the previous two shows, gave us a list of possible judges that are a reasonable distance from Creede. After reviewing and discussing options, we contacted Caroline Ellerman and she has agreed to judge our 2025 show. We met Caroline Ellerman was a fellow class member in Nancy's modern quilt class we had the day following our last guild meeting. Caroline is from Arizona but spends her summers in Montrose. Caroline is a National Certified Judge Candidate. She has judged county fair quilt shows in Colorado and Arizona. She has completed 2 ½ years of certified judge training and has participated in three certified judge practice judging. Nancy Fuqua is her mentor and highly recommended her as a possible judge for our show. At this time, she has not completed all the steps necessary to be a certified judge but feel she will be a good judge for our show.
