g. Quilt Show-Penny Snyder

1. Judge contacted for the Candidate Judge from Montrose. This Candidate Judge has done two or three judging, so not a completed certified Judge. But she will charge only \$300.00 plus expenses. She is highly

recommended. Penny will sign the contract for her to be our judge. She will stay at Snowshoe Motel and four others will help w/judging with her.

2. Positions are all filled for the show.

3. Antique Quilts: Linda Levesque will help Vi Koch

Emily 4. Publicity help is needed for running around and doing the task list with MacDonald.

5. Budget list passed out. \$1600 in 2023 for the recreation center. For 2025 Wednesday through Sunday is \$1000.00. Food Cafe will be managed by Don Ritz. \$75.00 a day for kitchen rental. 2025 will be \$300.00. Advertising was \$2,209.68 on last show. We have budgeted \$3,000.00. Much of budget is kept at same price as last time. Six vendors for this show are allowed so price for them up to \$250.00. Sponsors-\$300.00; Trailer-\$970.00. Need new signage-cost about \$200.00. Need insurance. Rent also added to find site for trailer--a 7x14" space needed. Raffle quilt account money goes to miscellaneous or trailer. Raffle quilt amount for this is \$500.00.

Insurance for show gives \$1,000,000 liability--important investment.

E. Mail Report-Pat Miller, STQG's P.O. Box Key holder:

a. P.O. Box Rental has increased to \$84.00 a year (an increase each year of about \$12.00).

F. Old Business-Penny Snyder:

a. Challenge Quilt must change rules to be clear for Judging. Still must be black and white and one other fabric. The one other fabric must be used for backing, also. It may have embellishments, but the embellishments with fabric has to be the one other fabric or black or white.

G. New Business-

a. UFOs to be made from Ginger Alexander's UFOs and fabrics. Pot holders can be made from her fabric for the Treasure Trove. Cut quilt batting passed out to guild to make two pot holders each for the treasure trove.

b. One more category added to quilt show-an Art Quilt category. It must be an original design.

c. Three volunteers were needed for nominating committee. These were filled. (Linda Woods, Tammy Hammel and ?)

d. Discussion on keeping content on Instagram and Facebook site. Historian will send information.

e. Pat Miller moved and Carolyn Flood second the motion and it was approved on the vote on proposed budget for June 2024-June 2025.

f. Hospitality-Stamps and cards added to this.
