## Quilt Check In

Check-in will take place Monday at the Creede Baptist Church. You can check-in your quilts anytime between 9:00-11:00 am. We suggest that those whose last name starts with A-L bring their quilts between 9-10 and those whose last name starts with M-Z check their quilts in between 10-11.

Each quilt should have your name and the name of the quilt sewn to the back.

- All quilts should have a 5" sleeve sewn to the back of the quilt (minimum 3" sleeve)
- The sleeve should be 1-2" below the top of the quilt.
- The sleeve should go nearly the full width of the quilt. (within 1-1.5" from the side)

Each quilt needs to be placed in its own cloth bag with a label listing the following on the bag

- Your name
- Name of the quilt/item
- Category
- Judged or Not Judged

\*\*Please fold your quilt and have the label of the quilt so it is visible when the quilt is pulled out of the bag.\*\*

# Show Week Schedule

Wednesday - Sept 17 8:00 am – 10:00 Lay the gym floor mat covering on the gym floor

8:30 am – 10:00 Transfer quilts from the church to the gym

8:30 am – 10:00 Transfer the storage building contents to the gym

10:00 – 11:30 Move the poles and stands from the trailer to the gym floor placing them according to the lay-out.

11:30-12:00 Lunch will be provided.

12:00 til done Putting up vendor poles and drapes in designated areas

12:00 til done Hang drapes in designated areas. Place quilts in their respective areas according to the layout.

Hang all quilts. We will assign a member to oversee hanging each quilt category. If you are not in charge of a category, please assist a category that is needing assistance.

9 am – 12:00 Sponsors will be selecting their favorite quilt and placing their ribbons.

9 am – finished Vendors arrive and set-up

1:30 Quilt show walk-through
